



## **Clara Brierly Festival of the Arts Workshop/Demo Schedule** ***Come Get Your Art On!!!***

### **Friday June 11, 2010**

#### **6:45 pm - 8:00 pm      Tami's Beginner Bracelet**

This is a beginner's jewelry making workshop. Cost to cover supplies is \$10; class is limited to 10 people so register and pay early to save your spot. All materials are provided. You will go home with a one of a kind bracelet you made as well as the know how to make more. Age limit - 14 and up.

#### **8:30 pm - 9:30 pm      Henna Workshop**

Learn this ancient, temporary body staining art form (can be done on other surfaces as well). Cost to cover supplies is \$15; class is limited to 12 people so register and pay early to save your spot. All materials are provided. You will go home with a piece you've done and information on how to do more. Age limit - no age limit but children under 14 must be accompanied by parent.

### **Saturday June 12, 2010**

#### **10 am - 11 am      Papermaking**

Learn to make your own paper! Cost to cover supplies is \$8; class is limited to 10 people so register and pay early to save your spot. All materials are provided. You will go home with a one piece of paper, instructions and the mould and deckle frames needed to make more at home. Age limit - no age limit for this workshop but children under 14 must be accompanied by parent.

#### **11:30 am - 12:30 pm      Lunch Break**

Tent will be open to those wanting a place to sit and enjoy a sandwich or some kettle corn.

#### **1 pm - 2 pm      Book Signing**

The wonderful story tellers who brought DPACD's patron artist, Miss Clara, to life will be on hand to sign Outsider Artist with a Traditional Heart: The Clara Brierly Story. If you already have a copy, bring it to be signed, if you don't have yours yet, purchase the book and DVD set at the Welcome Tent on the festival grounds or go to DPACD Stuff on [www.downtownpeculiar.com](http://www.downtownpeculiar.com) and we'll have yours waiting for you. signed if you get it to us before the festival. This book and DVD set won the Cass County Historical Society's Legacy Award for Publication given February 2010.

### **2:30 pm - 3:30 pm      Artist Trading Cards**

Artist trading cards are a way artists can own small pieces of art from several different artists. The cards are created and then traded with other artists (you can, of course, keep the ones you make). Some artists also use them like business cards. This workshop is free; class is limited to 15 people so register early to save your spot. All materials are provided. You will go home with several trading cards you have made as well as the know how to make more. No age limit for this workshop but children under 14 must be accompanied by a parent.

### **4 pm - 5 pm                  Pottery Demonstration**

Come watch as potter, Natalie Thomas, shows the process behind creating a piece of wheel thrown pottery. This demonstration is free, class is limited to how many people can crowd around her and still see! Natalie's pottery is well known in our area. Come see how a lump of clay becomes one of her beautiful pieces.

### **5:30 pm - 6:30 pm      Junque Bracelet**

This fun and funky class lets you leave with a personal masterpiece bracelet and instruction sheet. Please feel free to bring your own "junque" to use on the bracelet (must have a hole in item) but appropriate items will also be provided so no worries if you forget. Cost to cover supplies is \$6; class is limited to 8 people so register and pay early to save your spot. All materials are provided. You will go home with something uniquely you as the know how to make more. Age limit - 14 and up.

### **7 pm - 8 pm                  Hypertufa**

This workshop will teach you the basics to making a flat or vessel faux stone piece. Cost to cover supplies is \$20; class is limited to 6 people so register and pay early to save your spot. All materials are provided. You will go home with a piece you made as well as the know how to create other pieces for your yard and home. Due to safety protocol, age limit - 18 and up.

### **8:30 pm - 9:30 pm      Poetic Portraits**

This class will teach you to look at another person and create a portrait of their face and personality with words. There is no fee for this workshop; class is limited to 12 people so register early to save your spot. All materials are provided. You will go home with a poem you wrote as well as a copy of the one written for you. **YOU DO NOT NEED TO CONSIDER YOURSELF A POET TO DO THIS.** Age limit - 18 and up.

## **Sunday June 13, 2010**

### **12:30 pm - 1:30 pm      Art Mask**

Start with a form and create your own story on an art mask to take home and hang up. Cost to cover supplies is \$10; class is limited to 6 people so register and pay early to save your spot. All materials are provided. You will go home with a visual art piece that also tells a story, your story. Age limit - 14 and up.

**2:00 - 3:00**

**Flamenco Guitar Demo**

This MAC grant sponsored demonstration will make you shout Ole to the soul stirring gypsy music of Spain. There is no cost to attend but feel free to tip the artist if you appreciate his music; class is limited to the number of people who can crowd in. You will go home with the music in your head and thinking about buying a guitar!
